

April 1842

At a legal town meeting held on Monday April the 4th. D. 1842. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up & acted upon in the following manner, to wit,

1. Chose Capt. William Brigham. Moderator
2. Chose Webster Moore a Surveyor of Highways in place of Ephraim Moore declined serving. Then chose John H. Dakin on the school Committee in place of Ephraim Moore who refused to serve. Then excused Mahum Thompson from serving as Fence viewer and chose Israel Haynes to fill the vacancy. Then voted to excuse James Linn from serving as Field Driver and Gilbert Maynard was chosen to fill the vacancy. Then chose Nathan Haynes a surveyor of Lumber in place of Edward Fisher deceased. Then chose Asher Goodnow Esq. Sealer of Weights & Measures. Then voted to put over the choice of Constable and Collector for the present.
3. Granted the sum of five hundred Dollars for the support of the Poor the present year.
4. Granted the sum of six hundred and sixty Dollars for summer and winter schools, then voted to make an addition of fifty Dollars to said sum, then voted that the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars be divided equally between the five School Districts for summer schools, & four hundred & sixty Dollars for winter schools including fuel.
Voted to pass over the 5th. Article for the present and take up the 11th.
11. Voted that the Assessors take the invoice of personal property commencing on the first day of May and also to assess the taxes immediately after taking the invoice.
Then voted to take up the 5th. article.
5. Granted twenty five Dollars to pay Assessors and ten Dollars to pay the Treasurer the present year.
