6. Granted the sum of five hundred forty one Dollars and sixteen cents to pay damages and for making the Road petitioned for by Israel Hunt & others.
7. Granted the sum of one hundred twenty one Dollars and twenty five cents for making the widenings and straightenings in the Road petitioned for by Enoch Kidder & others.
9. Granted the sum of ninety seven Dollars and sixty five cents to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts.
10. Granted the sum of one hundred & twenty five Dollars for incidental expenses.
12. Voted to choose a Committee of one to oppose the Road petitioned for by Horace Heard & others, and chose Thomas Stearns Esq. for said Committee. Then voted to choose a Committee of one to oppose the Road petitioned for by Levi Smith & others, and chose Thomas Stearns Esq. for said Committee. Then voted to make ^{an} addition of one to said Committee and chose Capt. Abel B. Jones
13. Voted to choose a Committee of one to meet the County Commissioners at their meeting to locate the Road petitioned for by Nathan Pratt & others, and chose C. G. Cutler Esq.
14. Voted that the Committee sell the old Hearses and harness.

Then voted to take up the 2^d Article & chose Capt. Timothy Johnson Constable & Collector who engages to collect the taxes at one per cent and do all business usually done by the Constable.

Then voted to dissolve this meeting
