At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday August the eighth A 1842. the Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner, to wit:

- 2<sup>d</sup> Voted to choose a committee of three to oppose the road petitioned for by Asa Smith & others, and chose Asher Goodnow & C. G. Cutler Esqs, & James Moore for said committee.
- 3<sup>d</sup> Voted that Asher Goodnow & C. G. Cutler Esqs, & James Moore be a committee for the purpose expressed in this article.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Voted to pass over this article.
