3. To see if the town will take any measures to reimburse their School Committee for money expended by them for summer schools the past summer to do or act as the town shall think best.
4. To see if the town will require their School Committee to have the Instructors of the several schools in said town examined according to law and a certificate of their qualifications deposited with the Town Treasurer.
5. To discount certain taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
6. To see if the town will take any measures to procure the District Libraries for the several School Districts in said town agreeable to a Resolve of the Legislature of this Commonwealth, to do or act as the town shall think best.
7. To see if the town will take any measures to build a town house, to do or act as the town shall think best.
8. To see if the town will require their school Committee to cause the Parents Masters Guardians of Children who may damage the school house or houses to pay for repairing the same.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each public meeting house in said town fourteen days at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves on or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
