The Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz:

1st Chose Capt. William Brigham Moderator.

Then voted to adjourn this meeting to Tuesday the fifteenth inst. at one o'clock P.M.

Tuesday November the fifteenth the town met according to the aforesaid adjournment

2. Voted to choose a Committee of three to let out the making of the Road petitioned for by Noyes Smith & others and Chose William Brigham, Sona. W. Vose & James Moore for said Committee.

3 Voted to put over this Article to April Meeting.

4 Voted to passover this Article

5 Voted to passover this Article

6 Voted that the Treasurer be authorized to borrow seventy five Dollars on the credit of the town to procure the School District Libraries

Then voted that the School Committee be authorized to purchase the five first Libraries of Fowler & Copen

Then voted to choose a Committee of two from each School District to take charge of said Libraries and act as Librarians for the ensuing year, and make such rules regulations and by laws as they shall think best

to regulate and Govern said Libraries, and report the same to the town for their approval and chose Thomas Stearns, William Brigham, Ephraim Stone, Timothy Johnson, James Moore, Lyman How, Henry Vose Jr, John A. Maynard, Nahum Thompson, & Aaron Hunt for said Committee

7 Voted to passover this Article

8 Voted that the School Committee request the Instructors to inform said Committee of any damage done by the scholars to the school houses and said Committee cause the Parents or Masters of said Children to pay for repairing the same
