At a legal town meeting held at Sudbury February the 13th A. D. 1843 the following votes were given in viz.

The Articles in the preceding warrant were then taken up and acted upon in the following manner to wit:

- 1st. Chose Capt. William Brigham Moderator
2. Voted to accept a legacy bequeathed to said town by Gerusha Howe late of Sudbury deceased then voted that the Selectmen be authorized to receive the same
3. Voted to choose a Committee of five one from each school District to examine the Poor house and if they think best for the town to build a new house then to report to the town such a plan as they shall think best to adopt and also what the probable cost would be and chose Capt. Wm. Brigham, Charles Gary, Reuben Haynes Buckley Howe & Reuben Puffer for said Committee
