To Timothy Johnson Constable of the
town of Sudbury in said County Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massach-
usetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of
the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Elections
and town affairs to meet at the Meeting house of the
first Parish in said town on Monday the sixeth day
of March next at nine o'clock in the fore-
noon then and there to act on the following
articles viz:

1. To chorse a Moderator
- 2 To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer for
the County of Middlesex
- 3 To chorse all necessary Town Officers for the
year ensuing
- 4 To determine the manner of repairing highways
and bridges the year ensuing and grant money
for the same
- 5 To hear and act on all reports
- 6 To see if the town will chorse a Committee to
oppose the Road petitioned for by Levi Smith
& others
- 7 To see if the town will new District the town
and build one or more new School houses and
remove one or more of the old to do or act on
the subject of School Districts as the town shall
think best.
- 8 To see if the town will discount certain taxes
that may be offered.

And you are directed to serve this warrant
by posting up an attested copy thereof at each public
meeting house in said town fourteen days at least
