3rd Chose James Moore Town Clerk who was qualified in open meeting by C. G. Cutler Esq. Then chose for Selectmen *Jon. R. Rose *Ephraim Moore and *John Jones.

Overseers of the Poor Joseph Smith Reuben Puffer & James Moore

Treasurer Nahum Thompson

Choice of Constable & Collector put over to April meeting

Voted to choose a school committee of three, then voted to reconsider said vote and leave the whole subject of schools open for the action of the town at their adjourned meeting.

Then voted to adjourn this meeting to Monday the thirteenth inst. at ten o'clock A. M. To meet at the Meetinghouse of the First Parish.
