Voted to accept the settlement of the Selectmen with Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded Voted to accept the report of the Overseers of the Poor then voted that the Selectmen make out in tabular form the receipts and expenditures of the town the past year and have the same printed for the use of the town

Then heard the report of the Committee chosen to examine the poor house and voted to recommit the same with instructions that they further investigate the subject and report and report at April meeting

6. Voted to choose a Committee of three to oppose the Road petitioned for by Levi Smith & others & chose Asher Goodnow Asa Jones & Thomas Stearns
