To Timothy Johnson Constable of the town of  
Sudbury in said County of Middlesex Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in said town on Monday the third day of April next at twelve o'clock Meridian then and there to act on the following articles viz:

- 1 To choose a Moderator.
- 2 To choose all necessary town Officers not chosen at March meeting.
- 3 To see if the town will accept of a list of Errors as made out by the Selectmen.
- 4 To grant money for the support of the Poor the ensuing year.
- 5 To grant money for Summer & Winter Schools and order how the same shall be distributed and when expended.
- 6 To grant money to pay Treasurer & Assessors.
- 7 To grant money for incidental expenses.
- 8 To hear and act on all reports.
- 9 To grant money to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on Accounts.
- 10 To act on the third article in the warrant for last November meeting which was put over to April meeting.
- 11 To choose a committee to let out the making of the Road located by the County Commissioners on the petition of Nathan Pratt & others and grant money for making the same.
- 12 To choose a Committee to let out the making of the Road located on the petition of Levi Smith & others and grant money for making the same.
