- 13 To grant money to pay for making the straightnings & widening in the Road petitioned for by Moses Smith & others.
- 14 To see if the town will cause a railing to be placed on wash bridge and causeway.
- 15 To see if the town if they reimburse their School Committee fifty Dollars expended by them for summer schools the past year will allow them interest for the same to do or act as they think best.
- 16 To see what measures the town will take towards providing a place for calling their meetings for the year ensuing to do or act as they think best.
- 17 To see if the town will adopt the Districting system respecting schools to do or act on the subject of schools as the town shall think best.
- 18 To see if the town will accept the report of Committee chosen at a former meeting to examine the Poor house and act on the same to do or act on the subject of building a Poor house as the town shall think best.
- 19 To see if the town will discount certain taxes which may be offered.
- 20 To see if the town instruct their Assessors to take the valuation of Personal property the present year.
- 21 To see what method the town will take to collect their taxes the present year.

And are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each public meeting house in said town fourteen days at least before the time for holding said meeting.

I Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk on or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
