At a legal Meeting of the inhabitants of the town
of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs held on
Monday the third day of April D. 1843. The articles
in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon
as follows viz:

- 1 Chose Drury Fairbank Moderator
- 2 Voted to divide the north highway ward and choose one
more high way Surveyor and chose Solomon C Pratt
chose Jonas Bowers Pound Keeper in place of E. W. Haynes
chose Timothy Johnson Constable & Collector who engages
to collect all the taxes for one per cent except High
way taxes and also do all buisness usually done by
the Constable for the town free from charge to the town
- 3 Voted to accept of the list of jurors presented by the
Selectmen
- 4 Granted five hundred Dollars for the support of the
Poor the ensuing year
