- 5 Granted four hundred Dollars for Winter Schools and sixty Dollars for fuel to be equally divided between the five School Districts in said town to be expended for the School term commencing December 1843
Granted two hundred and fifty Dollars for Summer Schools to be equally divided between the five School Districts in said town to be expended for the summer term of 1844.
- 6 Granted the sum of ten Dollars to pay Treasurer and twenty five Dollars to pay Assessors.
- 7 Granted the sum of one hundred and twenty five Dollars for incidental expenses
- 8 Voted to accept the following reports viz:
The report of the Committee on Sherman's bridge and ordered said Committee to repair said bridge then excused J. R. Wood & Ephraim Moore from serving on said Committee and chose J. W. Gates & Aaron Hunt to fill the vacancies
- Voted to accept the report of the Committee chosen to let out the straightenings & widenings in the Road ordered by the County Commissioners on the petition of Noyes Smith & others which said Committee let out to the lowest bidder for the sum of seven hundred and forty two Dollars.
- 9 Voted to accept the report of the Committee on accounts and granted the sum of one hundred and sixty three Dollars and ten cents to pay the same.
- 10 Voted to reimburse the School Committee the sum of fifty Dollars out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury it being for money paid by said Committee for Summer Schools the past summer
- 11 Voted to choose a Committee of three to let out the making the Road located by the County Commissioners on petition of Nathan Pratt & others & chose William Brigham Levi Smith & J. R. Wood for said Committee
