6. To discount certain taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
7. To see what measures the town will take respecting the petition of Asa Smith & others to the County Commissioners to have the Town Road continued and laid out as a Town Road from his saw mill to New line.

And you are directed to serve this warrant, by posting up an attested copy thereof, at each public meeting house in said town, fourteen days at least, before the time for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to ourselves, on or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
