Committee on Accounts Drury Fairbank Abel B. Jones and Charles Gerry

1st Voted to Grant the sum of nine hundred ^{dollars} to Repair Highways townways and Bridges the ensuing year Voted that it be a money tax & apportioned in the same manner as last year the Surveyers to give each person an opportunity to work out their tax - Fixing the price of Labor at ten cents per hour.

3rd Voted to accept the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded.

Voted to accept the report of the Selectmen showing in tabular form the Receipts & expenditures of the town the past year.

Voted to accept the report of the Selectmen in referance to Guide Posts, then voted to instruct the Selectmen to erect Guide Posts in such places as they shall judge necessary.

Voted to accept the Report of the Overseers of the Poor and ordered the same to be recorded.

6th Voted to choose a committee of three to let out the making of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Charles Haynes and David Lincoln, Joseph Smith, and Charles Haynes, were chosen - Voted that ^{the} same committee let out the making of the Road on petition of Wm Brigham & others.

7th Voted to choose a committee of three to let out the making of a Road laid out by the County Commissioners on petition of Asa Smith & others and Levi Smith, Joseph Smith and Ashel Balcom were chosen

8th Voted to discount to Timothy Johnson the following taxes viz. Cyrus Taylors \$1.48 Jonathan Bacons \$1.48 Aaron Hunts \$1.36 further action on this article put over to April meeting

9th Voted to choose a committee of three to examine Wash Bridge & report at April Meeting chose Paul Walker, Ephraim Moore and Aaron Hunt
