9th Voted to accept the Report of the Committee on accounts then voted to allow Abel Parmenter account of \$5.50 - Voted to allow \$8.02 of Amos Conants account - then Voted to lay Mr Conants accounts on the Table - Voted to pass over this article for the present and take up the 10th

10th Voted to discount to Timothy Johnson the following Taxes vs. Heirs of Hopestill Brown of \$1.40 Boston & Fitchburg Stage Co. \$3.60 Heirs of Wm Hayden of \$2.52

Voted to adjourn this Meeting to Tuesday the second inst. at one O'clock P.M. at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish
