- Then Voted that so much of this article as relates to Mr Conant's account be put over to the next Meeting
- Voted to accept the Report of a committee to let out the Making of a Road on petition of Levi Smith
- Voted to accept the Report of the committee to let out the Making of a Road on petition of Asa Smith & others
- Voted to accept the Report of the committee chosen to examine Wash Bridge — Then Voted to instruct said committee to make all necessary repairs agreeable to their Report.
- Voted to accept the Report of a committee in reference to new districting the town
- Voted to accept the Report of the school committee then Voted to instruct the school committee to make such repairs upon school houses as they shall think best agreeable to said report.
- 6th Voted to take up the 6th Art — then Voted to Grant the sum of one hundred and forty five dollars & $\frac{44}{100}$ to pay accounts allowed by the committee on accounts & Abel Parmenter account allowed by the town
- 7th Voted to grant ten dollars to pay the Treasurer and twenty dollars to pay Assessors
- 8th Voted to Grant two hundred dollars for incidental expenses
- 11th Voted to Grant one hundred and seventy three dollars & $\frac{9}{100}$ to pay damages & for Making Road on petition of Charles Haynes And ninety one dollars & $\frac{5}{100}$ to pay for Making a Road on petition of Asa Smith & others
- 12th Voted to Grant forty dollars to pay damages for a Road on petition of William Brigham & others
- 13th Voted to Grant five hundred dollars to pay for Poor house
- 14th Voted to instruct the selectmen to provide a place for holding town Meetings
- 15th Voted to instruct the Assessors to take the Valuation of personal property the present year.
- 16th Voted that the several high way Surveyors for 1843 have an opportunity to work ^{out} the taxes of all delinquents untill the first of may next then return their books with their doings thereon to the Assessors.
