In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to Vote in town affairs to meet at the Hall of Charles Moore in said town on Saturday the twentieth day of July next at three O'clock in the afternoon then and there to act on the following articles viz

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to oppose before the County Commissioners the Road petitioned for by William H. Knight & others
- 3^d To see if the town will straighten the line between land of Moses Garfield David Haynes and land of the Poor Farm to do or act as the town shall think best.
- 4th To see if the town will hear a Report of the Selectmen in reference to the line between the Poor Farm and land of Reuben S. Willis to do or act as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each public Meetinghouse in said town fourteen days at least before the time for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk on or before the time of Meeting aforesaid.
