And you are furthermore required to notify the inhabitants of said town qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the above named time and place to act on the following articles viz;

- 1st To Choose a Moderator
- 2^d To see if the town will take Measures to have their buildings on the Poor Farm insured to do or act as they shall think best.
- 3^d To hear and act on all Reports
- 4th To take further action on the 3^d article of the Warrant of October the 14th which was put over to November Meeting.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copys thereof at each of the public Meetinghouses in said town fourteen days at least before the time for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk on or before the time of meeting aforesaid.
