- 6th Voted to Grant two hundred fortythree dollars $\frac{72}{100}$ to pay accounts allowed by the Committee on accounts and accounts allowed by the town.
- 7th Voted to Grant ten dollars to pay the Treasurer and twenty dollars to pay assessors.
- 8th Voted to Grant two hundred dollars for Incidental expences.
- 10th Voted to pass Over this Article.
- 11th Voted to pass Over.
- 12th Voted to give Elisha W. Haynes liberty to build a Tomb.
- 13th Voted to pass Over.
- 14th Voted to Grant eightytwo dollars to pay for damages and making Road laid out on petition of Sewell Hunt and others.
- 15th Voted that John P. Allen, David Lincoln, and Gardner Hunt be a Committee to let out the making of the Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Sewell Hunt — Then Voted that the expence of making said Road do not exceed thirty dollars
