Middlesex ss. Oct. 6th 1845. - Pursuant to the within warrant I have notified the said inhabitants of the town of Sudbury to meet at the within time and place by posting up an attested copy of said warrant at each of the public Meeting houses in said town fourteen days before the date hereof.

2^d Gave in their votes for Register of Deeds and they were for the following persons viz.

Ephraim B. Patch of Lowell forty nine

Reuben Moore of Concord fifteen

Isaac Robbins one

whole number sixty five

3^d Voted to lend Rev^d Mr Barry the town Records.

4th Voted that the Selectmen provide a place for holding Meetings

Then voted to dissolve the Meeting
