

December. 1845

At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the eighth day of December A 1845 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

1st Chose Col. Drury Fairbanks Moderator.

2^d Gave in their votes for Register of Deeds as follows viz.

For Ephraim B. Patch seventy nine.

" Reuben Moore eighteen.

" Caleb Hayden six.

Whole number one hundred three.

3^d Voted to build a townhouse.

Then voted to choose a Committee of five, one from each school district to procure a plan for a town house, select a suitable spot to sit the house, and to estimate the provable expence of the same, and make report at an adjourned Meeting.

The following persons were chosen that Committee viz.

William Brigham, Enoch Kidder, Ephraim Moore,

Joel Parmenter, and Aaron Hunt.

4th - Chose the following persons a committee to let out the making of the Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Sewell Hunt viz.

David Lincoln, Thomas B. Battles, and Joseph Smith

It was then voted to instruct said Committee not to let out the making of the Road further south than the line between land of Nathan C.

Haynes and Eben. Eaton. And further to request said Committee to ascertain if it is the intention of Mr. Eaton to remove a piece of wall on laid out for a Road. And Report at a future Meeting.

Then voted to adjourn this Meeting to Monday the twenty ninth inst. at one of the clock in the after noon.

Monday Dec. 29th A. 1845. — The town met according to the afore-said adjournment.

A Report of the Committee chosen to procure a plan for a town house, select a spot to sit the same, and estimate the expence was read and accepted. — in favor of accepting one hundred thirty against — " — sixty four.
