In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to
notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and
town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in said town on
Monday the fifth day of January next at one of the clock in the after noon
precisely to act on the following articles viz.

- 1st To Choose a Moderator.
- 2^d To bring in their votes for a Register of Deeds for the County of
Middlesex for the residue of the term for which William F. Stone Esqr
was elected to that office.
- 3^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to remove, and repair, the
Mill House on the Poor Farm. to do, or act, as they shall think best.
- 4th To see if the town will purchase Mitchell's large Maps for the use
of the several district schools to do, or act, as they shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attest-
ed copy thereof at each of the public Meetinghouses in said town two
Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your
doings thereon to the town clerk at or before the time of Meeting aforesaid.
