In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in said town on Monday the sixteenth day of February current at one of the clock in the afternoon precisely to act on the following articles viz

1st To choose a Moderator.

2^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to oppose the alteration in the line between the towns of Sudbury and Stowe, as prayed for on petition of William H. Knight and others, to do or act, as they shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each of the public Meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time of meeting aforesaid

Whereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk, at or before the time of holding said meeting.
