

February 1846 —

At a legal town Meeting held on Monday February 16th A.D. 1846
by the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury the article in the preceding
warrant was taken up, and acted upon, in the following manner viz.

1st Chose Col. Drury Fairbanks Moderator.

2^d Voted to choose a Committee of three to oppose the alteration
in the line between the towns of Sudbury and Stow as prayed for
on petition of William H. Knight and others. And that said
Committee use all fair and lawful means to prevent the same.
— with power to employ Council.

The following persons were chosen said Committee viz.

Capt. Abel B. Jones, Col. Drury Fairbanks and Aaron Hunt.

Voted to dissolve said Meeting.
