L.S.To Timothy Johnson Constable of the
town of Sudbury in said County Greeting

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed
to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town
affairs to meet at the Meetinghouse of the first Parish in said town on
Monday the sixth day of April next at ten of the clock in the forenoon
precisely to act on the following articles viz.

- 1st To choose a Moderator
- 2^d To choose all necessary town officers not chosen at March Meeting.
- 3^d To Grant Money for the support of the Poor the ensuing year.
- 4th To Grant Money for Summer and Winter Schools and order
how the same shall be distributed and when expended.
- 5th To Grant Money to pay the Treasurer and Assessors.
- 6th To Grant Money for incidental expenses.
- 7th To hear and act on all Reports.
- 8th To Grant Money to pay account allowed by the Committee on Accounts.
- 9th To take further action on the fifth article in the warrant for March
Meeting put over to April Meeting.
- 10th To see if the town will so alter the limits of the Highway wards at
the North part of the town as to make an additional ward, to do or
act as they shall think best.
- 11th To see if town will instruct their School Committee to number
the School districts.
- 12th To see if the town will accept of a list of jurors as made out by
the Selectmen.
- 13th To see if the town will discount certain taxes that may be offered.
- 14th To see if the town will appropriate the unappropriated money in
the Treasurers hands to pay the town debts to do or act as they shall
think best.
- 15th To see if the town will choose a Committee to remove and
repair the Mill House on the Poor Farm to do or act as they
shall think best.
