16th To see if the town will give their town house Committee any instructions in reference to a spot to set the town house upon, to do or act as they shall think best.

17th To see if the town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on the petition of Lyman Howe Esq & others. And grant a suitable sum of Money for the damage and making said Road.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each of the public Meeting houses in said town fourteen days at least before the time for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk at or before the time of Meeting aforesaid.
