

April 1846

At a legal town meeting held at Uudbury April 6th 1846 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

- 1st Chose Nahum Thompson Esq. Moderator.
- 2^d Excused Samuel M. Bowker from serving as highway surveyor and chose Thaddeus Garfield in his place. Voted to pass this art. for the present. - It was then voted to accept of the warning of this Meeting.
- 3^d Voted to grant two hundred and fifty dollars for the support of the Poor the ensuing year.
- 4th Voted to grant two hundred and fifty dollars for Summer Schools for the year 1847 - Voted to grant four hundred dollars for Winter Schools and sixty dollars for fuel - then voted to add fifteen dollars to the amount granted fuel, and if not needed for fuel to be expended for schools. - Voted that the sum granted for schools be equally divided among the several districts.
- 5th Voted to grant ten dollars to pay the Treasurer. and twenty dollars to pay assessors.
- 6th Voted to grant one hundred dollars for incidental expenses.
- 7th The School Committees report was read and accepted.
- 8th Voted to pass over this Article for the present.
- 9th Voted that the Committee chosen at March Meeting to investigate the subject of repairing the Highways, be called upon to make their report. Said report was read and accepted and ordered to be recorded.

Report.

Your Committee chosen March 3^d 1846 to investigate the subject of repairing the Highways and townways the year ensuing and make report at April Meeting have attended to that service and as it leave to report.

1st That the town grant the sum of eight hundred dollars to be expended by the several surveyors within their limits assigned them by the Selectmen and the money allotted to them by the assessors to repair the Highways and townways, and that the aforesaid sum be expended before the first day of December next.

2^d That the town grant the sum of two hundred dollars for the Winter use
