At a legal town Meeting held at Sudbury on Monday the eleventh day of January D. 1847 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner. viz.

1st Chose Col. Quiry Fairbank Moderator.

2^d The town house Committee were called upon to make their report the Chairman of said Committee stated that they had no report to make the Committee at the request of the town gave their reasons for not accepting of the house.

The town then voted to instruct the town house Committee to accept of the house.

3^d Voted to discount to Timothy Johnson the following taxes viz.

Jeddethan Willis tax of \$1.42. — Uriah Brown tax of \$1.48

Franklin Smiths tax of \$1.42 and Sereno D. Hunts tax of \$1.42 were presented for discount by Timothy Johnson. Voted not to discount.

Franklin Smiths tax of \$1.32 was presented for discount by Asahel Balcom. Voted not to discount said tax.

Then Voted to dissolve the Meeting.
