In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are directed to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Meeting house of the first parish in said town on Monday the first day of March next at nine O'Clock in the forenoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

- 1st To Choose a Moderator.
- 2^d To bring in their votes for a County Treasurer for the County of Middlesex.
- 3^d To Choose all necessary town officers for the year ensuing.
- 4th To determine the manner of repairing Highways and Bridges the year ensuing and grant money for the same.
- 5th To hear and act on all reports.
- 6th To hear and act on the report of the town house Committee.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at each of the public Meeting houses in said town fourteen days at least before the time set for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
