To Asahel Balcom Constable of the town of  
Sudbury in said County. — Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are required to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in Elections and Town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Monday the fifth day of April next at ten O'Clock in the forenoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

- 1<sup>st</sup> To bring in to the Selectmen their written votes for three County Commissioners all on one ballot. And two Special Commissioners on one ballot, for the County of Middlesex.
- 2<sup>d</sup> To choose a Moderator.
- 3<sup>d</sup> To choose all necessary town officers not chosen at March Meeting.
- 4<sup>th</sup> To act on the 4<sup>th</sup> article in the warrant for March Meeting.
- 5<sup>th</sup> To grant money for all necessary purposes the ensuing year.
- 6<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will direct how the school money shall be distributed and when expended.
- 7<sup>th</sup> To hear and act on all reports.
- 8<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will give the inhabitants thereof the use of the Town Hall for Lectures Literary and Scientific Lectures to do or act as they shall think best.
- 9<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will appropriate the fund left by the late Joshua Howe to pay for their town house to do or act on this article as they shall think best.
- 10<sup>th</sup> To see if the town will discount any Taxes that may be presented.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at each of the public meeting houses in said town fourteen days at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
