Noted to instruct the Selectmen to employ some suitable person to take charge of the town house. Noted that a bell be rung for town Meetings, and that the Keys of the town house be kept at the office of the town clerk.

9th Noted to authorize the town house Committee to give their Notes in behalf of the town of Cudbury to Mahum Thompson Esq. Treasurer of said town and his successor in office for the sum of one thousand dollars which sum being a legacy left to the town by the late Jerusha Howe
