Voted to grant the sum of three hundred seventy one dollars and forty seven cents being the amount due for the town house.

Voted to grant the sum of one hundred seventeen dollars and two cents to pay accounts allowed by the committee on accounts.

Voted to grant the sum of four hundred forty three dollars to pay the town debt.

3^d Voted to take up the 3^d article. Chose Asahel Balcom Constable & Collector who agrees to collect the taxes for one and a half per cent and do all other business usual if done by the Constable free of expence to the town.

10th Voted to discount to Asahel Balcom Collector the following taxes viz.

Israel Willis Tax \$ 1.44

Stillman Willis " \$ 1.44

Dennis Hatch " \$ 1.44
