

April 1847.

At a legal Meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the nineteenth day of April A.D. 1847 the articles in the foregoing warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

- 1st Chose Capt James Moore Moderator.
- 2^d The following persons declined serving as Highway Surveyors viz. Israel Hunt, Levi Dow, John Sawyer, Rubin Haynes Jr. Augustus Abard - and said vacancies were filled as follows viz. Levi Dow, Joel Parmenter, Lewis Brigham Timothy Johnston.
Charles Perry, Joseph C. Howe and Nahum Thompson declined serving as School Committee. Chose Enoch Kidder, Willard Walker, and Nahum Thompson to fill said vacancies.
- 3^d Voted to pass over.
- 4th Voted to instruct the Town House Committee to procure a suitable Chandelier for the Town Hall.
- 5th Voted to instruct the School Committee for 1846 to take measures to have their report printed at the expence of the Town and that four hundred Copies be distributed for the use of the inhabitants.
- 6th Voted to accept of the report of the Town House Committee and grant money to pay the amount agreeable to their report.

A further report from the Town House Committee.

The Committee have furnished Capt. Tilly Smith with a Stable in the room of his own which was taken by the committee for the sum of \$ 15.50

The committee have leveled the gravel round the Town House the bill is 21.00

The expence of boarding up M. Aaron Hunts Shed

Received for the old Timber of the Sheds

The Committee have charged for their services rendered

And the Committee request the town to grant the above amount.
