

Sept- 1847

At a legal Meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs held on Monday the thirteenth day of September A.D. 1847 the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner viz.

- 1st Chose Capt. Abel B. Jones Moderator.
- 2^d Voted to pass this article for the present and take up the 3^d.
- 3^d Voted to appropriate the amount agreeable to the article
- 4th Voted that the Overseers of the Poor be a Committee to dispose of the Millhouse in such a manner as in their opinion shall be most for the interest of the town.

Voted to take up the second article

Voted adjourn the Meeting for twenty minutes

Met according to adjournment and voted to instruct the Selectmen to confer with the Methodist Society and make such arrangement with them as shall induce said Society to consent to have the school house remain where it now stands for the present, the town paying a reasonable amount to compensate them for the same.

Voted to dissolve the Meeting.
