The Overseers made a Verbal Report in reference to a bill brought against the town on account of the family of Henry Dean.

Voted that the new board of Overseers be authorized to settle said bill any way which in their opinion shall be the most for the interest of the town.

6th Voted to choose a Committee of five one in each school district to take into consideration the subject matter of this article that they be requested to examine the school houses, and make a report of their doings at April meeting. Chose - Otthello C. Johnson, Edward Brown, Loring Wheeler, Walter Rogers Jr. Joel Parmenter, said Committee.

Voted that the School Committee be a Committee to frame a code of by-laws to protect the school houses from injury.

7th Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to examine the the Bridges mentioned in this article and Report at a future meeting.

Voted to dissolve the Meeting
