3^d Voted to grant four hundred and sixty five dollars for the support of the Poor

" " " ten dollars to pay Treasurer.

Voted to pass this article and take up the 2^d

Excused John W. Haynes from serving as Assessor & chose Charles Gerry. Excused Lyman Howe from serving as one of the School Committee chose Joseph C. Howe
