In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the town hall in said town on Monday the eighth day of May next at one of the clock in the afternoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

1st To Choose a Moderator2^d To See if the town will grant money to pay for the repairs on the Road near Mr. Edward Browns. and for repairing Lanham Bridge. and for building the Bridge near Mr. Sewell Hunts.3^d To See if the town will give the Selectmen any instructions in reference to the line between the towns of Frammingham and Sudbury to do or act as the town may think best.4th To See if the town will further instruct the School House Committee in reference to repairing the several School Houses in town. to do or act on the Subject of School Houses or School Districts as the town may think best when met. And grant money for the same.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the town house in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.
