At a Legal town meeting held by the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury on Monday the eighth day of May A. D. 1848 the articles in the foregoing warrant were taken up and acted upon in the following manner. viz.

1st Chose Capt. James Moore Moderator

2^d Voted to grant the sum of one hundred and seventy five dollars to pay for Road and Bridges mentioned in this article

4th Voted to instruct the School house Committee to build a School house in the Center School District, and Sell the Old house. that they be instructed to repair the school houses in the other four districts and enlarge them if in the opinion of the Committee it is necessary. That they put said School houses in a suitable condition to accommodate the schools in the several Districts. It was then Voted to instruct said Committee to remove the Lanham School house a short distance north of its present location

Voted to grant the sum of one thousand dollars to build and repair the school houses

Voted to take up the 3^d article

3^d Voted to instruct the Selectmen to examine the records in reference to the line between the town of Frammingham and Sudbury, and report at a future Meeting.

Then Voted to dissolve the Meeting
