At a legal town Meeting held at Sudbury on Monday the fourth day of September A. 1848. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

- 2<sup>d</sup> Voted to accept of the Report of the Selectmen in reference to purchasing a lot of land for a school house lot.
- 3<sup>d</sup> Voted to pass this article for the present
- 4<sup>th</sup> Voted to accept the alteration made in the Road near the house of J. D. Cutter on petition of Walter Rogers Sen & others
- Voted to take up the third article
- Voted not to accept of the Report of the Selectmen in reference to laying out a piece of land for a school house lot. on land of Capt. Uriah Moore.
- Then Voted to instruct the School house Committee to set the new School house on the common near the Hay Scales.
- in favor—twenty. against—fifteen.
- Then Voted to dissolve the meeting.
