by Marking or obscene Writing or Drawing of any sort upon any part of said houses or buildings appertaining thereto. Shall be subject to pay such sum of Money as shall be considered in the estimation of the School Committee a reasonable remuneration for such damage or disfigurement; and all such money received shall be placed in the Treasury of the Town for the benefit of the School or School House in the District from which it may be obtained as may be deemed proper.

Provided. If any Parent or Guardian shall neglect or refuse to pay a reasonable award for damage to be obtained as above specified such award shall be added to the annual tax of such persons and collected accordingly."
