4th To determine the manner of repairing high ways & Bridges the year ensuing and grant Money for the same.

5th To hear and act on all Reports.

6th To see if the town will discount any taxes that may be presented for discount.

7th To see if the town will take any measures to widen and repair the Road leading from Lasham School house to Frammingham line to do or act as the town shall think best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the town house and each of the public meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

None of fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
