- 8th To determine the manner of Collecting the taxes that may be assessed against the inhabitants of said town and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
- 9th To act on the seventh article in the warrant for march meeting
- 10th To see for what purposes and on what terms the town will allow the town hall to be used the ensuing year to do or act on said subject as the town shall think best
- 11th To see if the town will compensate Daniel W. Moore for a Road through his land on "Pecum" so called near Col. Moores or open the Road where it was laid out to do or act as the town shall think best
- 12th To see if the town will set off a School District on the Westerly part of the town to do or act as the town shall think best.
- 13th To see if the town will discount any taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
- 14th To direct how the School Money shall be distributed and when expended.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the town house and each of the public Meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meetings.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
