

April 1849.

At a Legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the second day of April A.D. 1849, the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

1st Chose Capt. James Moore Moderator

2^d Voted to excuse Ebenezer Stewart and John P. Allen from serving as field Drivers and chose John Sawyer and Abel B. Richardson
Voted to excuse Nahum Goodnow Jun. Solomon Searles Israel Hunt from serving as Highway Surveyors and chose William Stone Adarn M. Smith and Leander Haynes

Voted to pass the article for the present

3^d Voted to Grant the following sums of Money for the following purposes viz.
For the Support of the Poor eight hundred dollars
To Pay Assessors twenty dollars
To Pay Treasurers ten dollars
For Summer Schools three hundred twenty five dollars
For Winter Schools four hundred dollars
For Fuel seventy five dollars
For Incidental Expences two hundred dollars
To Pay Interest on the Peusha Howe Fund sixty dollars
To Pay Town Debt twelve hundred forty dollars
To Pay for Road & Bridge at Knights Factory thirteen hundred ten dollars
To Pay Accounts allowed two hundred thirty four dollars eighty three cts.

4th Voted to Grant the sum of one thousand dollars to repair Highways townways and Bridges the ensuing year and the same be expended in the same manner as last year

Voted that each Surveyor have a warrant and they be made Collectors

Voted that the Surveyor be directed to erect Railings at all dangerous places ~~is~~ within their limits, Voted that the town pay for materials used for Railings and covering Stones for Sluces when they cannot be procured in the limits of the highways.

Voted to instruct the Assessors to make out the limits for the Highway Surveyors.

5th Voted to accept of the list of Cusors as made out by the Selectmen.
