

April 1849.

- 6th Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to defend the suit brought by the First Parish against S. A. Jones and others and that said Committee be instructed to employ such aid as they shall think necessary.
- 7th Voted to accept of the Report in reference to the letting out and building the Road and Bridge at Knights & Maynards Factory.
- Voted to accept of the Report of the Committee on accounts
- then Voted that the Selectmen be instructed to take council in reference to taxation for income.
- 8th Voted that the taxes be collected in the same manner as last year, and that the collecting be let out to the lowest bidder with the understanding that he shall copy the warrants for town meetings and post one copy at the town house and each of the Public meetinghouses and do all other business usually done by the Constable free of expence to the town.
- Asahel Balcorn agrees to collect the taxes for seventy nine cents on the hundred dollars he being the lowest bidder is declared collector.
- Then Voted to take up the 2^d Art. and chose for Constable Samuel A. Jones.
- It was then Voted to strike out so much of the Vote taken under the 8th art. as has reference to Copying warrants and other business usually done by the Constable
- 9th Voted to pass over.
- 10th Voted that the town Hall be used for the same purposes and on the same terms as last year.
- 11th Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to examine the Road referred to in this article and report at a future meeting.
- 12th Voted to pass over.
- 13th Voted to discount to Samuel A. Jones Collector the following taxes viz.
