Art. 4th Voted that the Selectmen be a committee to examine the Road near Solomon Duttons and direct the Highway surveyor to make the same safe and convenient to travel

Art. 5th Voted that Aaron Hunt, Joseph Smith, & Abel B. Jones be a committee to examine Bridges referred to in this article and if in their opinion it is necessary to Rebuild or Repair said Bridges that they be instructed to carry the same into effect.

Art. 6th Voted not to take Timber from the Poor Farm to Repair Bridges.

Art. 7 Voted that Capt William Brigham Capt Abel B. Jones & Joseph Smith be a Committee to go out and examine the Nease House & Repod at this meeting. came in & Reported then Voted to instruct said Committee to make such Repairs as they shall think best.

Art. 8th Voted to discount to S. A. Jones collector Henry Bulls Tax of \$2.16

Art. 9th Voted to Pass over.
