In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified to vote at Elections and in town affairs to meet at the town Hall in said town on Monday the first day of April next at ten of the clock in the forenoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

- Art 1st To bring in to the Selectmen their votes for three County Commissioners and two Special County Commissioners all on one ballot for the County of Middlesex.
- Art 2^d To choose a Moderator
- Art 3^d To choose all necessary town officers not chosen at March Meeting and fill all vacancies that may occur by non-acceptance
- Art. 4th To see if the town will make an addition to their present school Committee to do or act as the town may think best.
- Art. 5th To act on the fifth and eighth articles in the warrant for March meeting.
- Art. 6th To see if the town will grant money or authorize the Treasurer to borrow money to pay the expenses of the Law suit now pending between said town and the first Parish, to do or act, as the town shall think best.
- Art. 7th To hear and act on all Reports.
- Art. 8th To Grant money for all necessary town purposes for the year ensuing
- Art. 9th To see for what purposes the town will allow the town hall to be used for, the year ensuing to do or act on said Subject as the town may think best.
- Art 10 To see if the town will purchase a Stove and furniture for the unfinished lobby in the town house to do or act as the town may Judge best.
- Art 11th To see if the town will accept of the New Bridge Road (so called) as re located by the Selectmen on petition of John M. Haynes and others.
- Art 12th To determine the manner of collecting the Taxes that may be assessed against the inhabitants of said town the present year and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
- Art. 13th To see if the town will instruct the assessors to print for the use of the inhabitants, the valuation of Real & Personal property in said town for the year 1850. to do or act as the town may think best.
