Art 1st To choose a Moderator

Art 2^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to let out the making of the Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of William Maynard & others.

Art 3^d To see what further measures the town will take to Repair the several Roads in town to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 4th To see if the town will choose an agent or agents to meet the County Commissioners on the petition of Aaron J. Thompson and others.

Art. 5th To see if the town will excuse Calvin Morse from serving as collector of Taxes the present year, to do or act as the town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town house and each of the Public Meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
