At a Legal meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified to vote at Elections held on Monday the nineteenth day of August A. D. 1850. it being the third Monday of said month the following votes were given in sorted & counted and declaration thereof made as the constitution requires viz.

For Representative to Congress.

Whole number of Ballots one hundred and twelve

For Richard Frothingham Jr. fifty

" Benjamin Thompson thirty eight

" John G. Palfray twenty four

The articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art. 1st Chose Capt James Moore Moderator.

Art 2nd Voted that the Selectmen be a committee to let out the marring of the Road laid out on petition of William Maynard & others.

Art 3^d Voted to Pass over.

Art 4th Voted that the Selectmen be a committee to oppose before the County Commissioners the location of a Road as petitioned for by Aaron S. Thompson & others. And to procure such other aid as they shall think necessary.

Art 5th Voted to Pass over.

Then Voted to Dissolve the meeting.
