At a Legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury held on Monday the second day of September A.D. 1850. the articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art. 1 Chose Capt. James Moore Moderator.

Art. 2^d Voted to Pass over.

Art. 3^d Voted to let out the Collecting of Taxes to the lowest bidder. Elisha W. Haysus being the lowest bidder agrees to collect the Taxes for one per cent then voted to accept of Elisha W. Haysus as Collector of Taxes the present year.

Art. 4th Voted that Col. Quincy Fairbanks Capt. William Brigham & Col. Ephraim Moore be a Committee to examine said yard, and report at a future meeting.

Art. 5th Voted that the same Committee take into consideration the subject referred to in this article and report at some future meeting.

Art. 6th Voted to Pass over.

Art. 7th Voted to instruct the Selectmen to partition off a suitable room under the Town Hall for a Snuary at the expense of the Town.

Voted to dissolve the Meeting.
